

What is Monesia?

Monesia stands for **MO**bility **N**etwork **E**urope-**S**outhamerica: an Institutional Approach. It is an *Erasmus Mundus External Cooperation Window* which organizes and manages scholarships financed by the European Commission for members of the Monesia partner universities and nationals from Brazil, Paraguay and Uruguay. Selected grantees may follow a credit transfer, short stay or full degree programme at one of the partner universities.

What are the aims of Monesia?

- ★ To allow undergraduates, master students, doctoral students, post-doctoral fellows and academic staff to gain valuable experience, knowledge and contacts abroad.
- ★ To provide improved education and training opportunities for vulnerable groups and socioeconomically disadvantaged students, and promote equal access to higher education for students from least developed regions.
- ★ To exchange knowledge, know-how and experience between Europe and Latin-America reinforcing the teaching and research skills of the partner universities.

How does the scholarship scheme work?

For nationals from EU countries

If you are enrolled at a European partner university you can apply for:

- ★ Credit transfer programmes (undergraduate, master)
- ★ Short stays (doctorate, post-doctorate, staff)

For nationals from Brazil, Paraguay and Uruguay

If you are enrolled at a Latin American partner university you can apply for:

- ★ Credit transfer programmes (undergraduate, master)
- ★ Short stays (doctorate, post-doctorate, staff)
- ★ Full degree programmes (master, doctorate)

If you are enrolled at a higher education institution in Brazil, Paraguay or Uruguay not included in the Monesia partnership you can apply for:

- ★ Credit transfer programmes (master)
- ★ Short stays (doctorate, post-doctorate)
- ★ Full degree programmes (master, doctorate)

If you have obtained a university degree in Brazil, Paraguay or Uruguay you can apply for:

- ★ Short stays (doctorate, post-doctorate)
- ★ Full degree programmes (master, doctorate)

If you belong to a disadvantaged group (such as ethnic minorities, refugees, asylum seekers, economically disadvantaged and disabled persons) you can apply for:

- ★ Credit transfer programmes (undergraduate, master)
- ★ Short stays (doctorate, post-doctorate)
- ★ Full degree programmes (undergraduate, master, doctorate)

What does the scholarship cover?

The scholarship covers a monthly allowance, tuition fee, travel expenses (round trip) and health insurance.

Level of mobility	Duration	Monthly allowance
Undergraduate	10 to 34 months	€ 1,000
Master	10 to 22 months	€ 1,000
Doctorate	6 to 34 months	€ 1,500
Post-doctorate	6 to 10 months	€ 1,800
Staff	2 months	€ 2,500

What disciplines are offered?

All partner universities offer a wide range of disciplines. As Monesia focuses strongly on regional needs, the following six specific thematic areas will be given priority in the selection process:

- ★ Agriculture
- ★ Education and Teacher Training
- ★ Engineering and Technology
- ★ Medical Sciences
- ★ Natural Sciences
- ★ Social Sciences
